

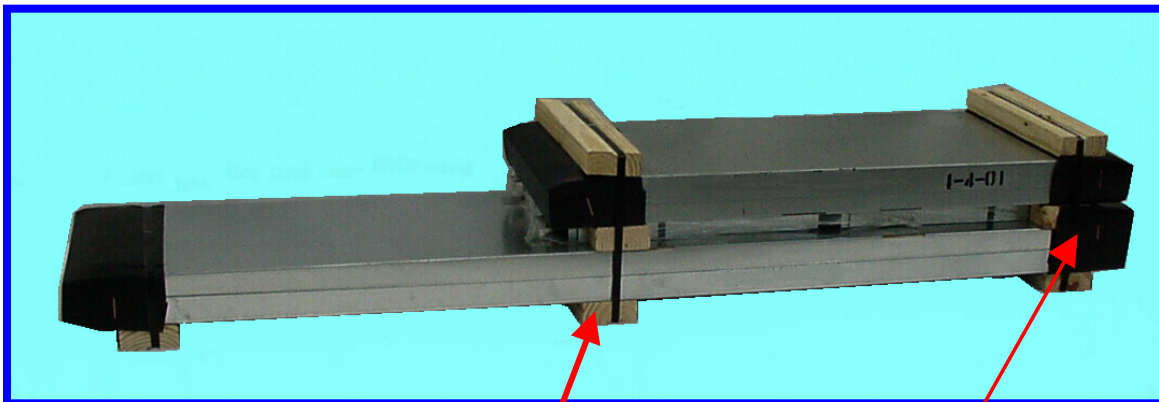


## Rooftop Systems Inc. Standard Roof Curb Packaging

Packaging is an important part of any roof curb design. When we at RSI ship roof curbs we will stack a group of curbs together to form a “cube”. We then stretch wrap the “cube” to give it stability and make it easy to handle by the freight carrier. Our standard packaging consist of *recycled plastic* end caps to protect the ends of the curbs, and wood blocks that separate each curb so a fork lift can easily move the curbs. Plastic end caps allow the curbs to be stored outside without weather damage. We also provide bar code labels when required.

Many curb manufactures ship the curbs with no end cap protection, or with only a metal angle bent to try to cover the ends. They also do not use the fork lift blocks. This results in increased freight damage and handling damage at the distribution level. The added cost of packaging pays for itself in less damage. We will gladly provide sample curbs for your review.
